

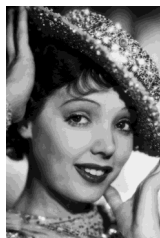

Intinction: Dipping the Bread into the Chalice



People receiving holy communion are reminded **not** to dip (intinct) the bread (host) into the wine. Such practice is

heavily discouraged by the Church of England and, at St Martin's, we have some people who are severely allergic to the gluten in the wafers. The slightest presence of it causes anaphylaxis. If you are concerned about spreading infection, you can simply receive the bread only; this is just as sacramentally valid. Thank you! Fr Robert.
