Today's Readings:

Ezekiel 18:25-28 The prophet reminds the people that when the sinner renounces their sin and amends their life that person lives!

Philippians 2:1-11 This one of the most famous sections in Paul's writings. Adopted by the early Church as a hymn and Creed, it tells us to be like Christ who willingly 'emptied' himself to redeem humanity. As St Athanasius say, 'God became human so that we might become divine'.



Matthew 21:28-32 Today's parable is once again set in a vineyard. Once again the Chief Priests and Scribes are the target for Jesus as they talk about the work of God, but don't end up doing it. One day they will be shocked by who did God's will and so enter his kingdom.
