

ST MARTIN'S PARISH CHURCH RUISLIP
ANNUAL PAROCHIAL CHURCH MEETING
ON TUESDAY 15TH MARCH 2022

Introduction

1. Archdeacon Catherine welcomed everyone to the meeting and opened with a prayer. She then informed everyone that she would be Chairing the meeting. She explained there would be two meetings. The first a meeting of those on the electoral role and the people of the parish to elect two churchwardens. The second meeting being of people on the electoral role to elect 1 member to join the Deanery Synod and 15 members to the PCC.
2. Archdeacon Catherine thanked the Area Dean for his help in putting the meeting together also thanking Father Yaro and the ministry team in particular the Churchwardens who have significant responsibility during a period of vacancy.
3. Archdeacon Catherine stated that the business would be kept short with no speeches except from anybody standing from the floor. Counting may take a while and thanks were given to the Deanery team who were undertaking the task of counting the votes. She stated that in the event of a tie the tied candidates would be reviewed.
4. Archdeacon Catherine explained that reaction to the results may be strong and asked that a round of applause be the only reaction shown.
5. The first meeting of the newly elected PCC would be on Sunday 20th March at 10.45. This would be a short meeting for appointments to be made and roles agreed. Forms will be sent out to the newly elected members for them to choose their preferred roles.

Meeting of people on the electoral role and people of the parish

1. This meeting to elect Churchwardens
2. Alan Seymour informed those present that he was standing down as Churchwarden
3. Arch Deacon Catherine thanked Alan for his work and as he was standing down announced that Jacqueline Alderton and Ian Keys are appointed as churchwardens for St Martins
4. The meeting was then closed

Meeting of people on the Electoral role

This meeting to elect a Deanery Synod representative and 15 PCC members

Electoral Role. Jo Wild reported that the new number on the Roll is 543, up from 525 from last year. The changes were 27 new members, 4 deaths and 5 people had moved away.
